## ZANZIBAR EXCURSION

#### Feb 24: DRIVE BACK TO ARUSHA & FLY TO ZANZIBAR

You will leave the lodge in the morning and drive to Arusha Airport where you will board a local flight and fly to Zanzibar. Our local guide in Zanzibar will meet you upon your arrival at Zanzibar Airport and transfer you to your overnight hotel situated in the heart of Stone Town at the picturesque seafront. You will spend the rest of the evening on your own walking, shopping and exploring around Stone Town or just relaxing at the hotel enjoying sunset over the Indian Ocean. (*Bed & Breakfast*)

#### Feb 25: GUIDED HISTORIC TOUR OF STONE TOWN AND SPICE FARM

Our local guide in Zanzibar will meet you in the morning after breakfast and take you on a guided tour of the historic Stone Town. You will stroll down the narrow labyrinthine streets of Stone Town which will takes you back 150 years, to when Zanzibar was the trading center of East Africa. You will catch a glimpse of the ornate latticework on a balcony, an Indian influence to the intricacy of sunwarmed wood on a carved door or catch sight between the tumbling roofs of the spire of the Anglican, or the Catholic Cathedral. In the afternoon, you will enjoy exploring the Spice Route. Zanzibar is known affectionately as The Spice Island because of its history as a producer of cloves and its position on the ancient spice routes. In the evening, our guide will transfer you to your beach hotel located in the eastern beach of Zanzibar. (*Half-Board*)
